



Commercial Pilot Training Scheme

Pilot training is an ambitious plan of the State Govt. after a study conducted by the state government, it has been seen that the benefits of the reservation policy of the Indian Govt. for the tribal class people are not available in the work areas like pilot. As per reservation a number of posts of pilots in the govt. sectors for the tribal class is lying vacant. That is why the department has decided to start this plan in a successful manner.

Purpose: -

The purpose of this plan is to provide free professional pilot training to the girls & boys belonging to Scheduled Tribe.

Structure: -

The welfare department has started giving free professional pilot training to 25 students belonging to the Scheduled Tribe. There is a condition attached for the beneficiaries of this plan, under which, after attaining the training and getting a job he will have to bear the cost of education upto Graduation level from class-V of two Tribal Students from their village or locality as selected by the Welfare Department.

Process: -

According to this plan students are selected on the basis of written / physical test conducted after they apply for the same on the basis of the advertisement published in various newspapers. There after they are sent for training to two flying training institutes at Kanpur & Pondichery.
